

## **REGISTERING A CAPTURED GUY FAWKES HERITAGE HORSE**

### **SECTION ONE**

1. Registration is not automatic; you must apply for registration for each individual horse.
2. You must be a full current financial member of the GFHHA to register your horse or register a prefix.
3. Adult Horse registration is lifetime for current financial members.
4. When you purchased your horse from the GFHHA, you will have received an NPWS Identification record form. Include a copy of this form with your registration application. If you did not receive one contact the Assn.
5. Fill in the registration application form as required. Put the name you wish to call your horse in the “horse name” field. As your horse has a capture ID number it is classified as “foundation stock” in the Stud Book and therefore will receive the “Guy Fawkes” prefix. E.g., if your horse is called Fred, and his capture ID number is “FF1”, his registered name will be “Guy Fawkes FF1 Fred”.
6. As nobody knows the date of birth or the sire and dam of these horses, just put “unknown” in these fields.
7. If your mare foals within 11 months of capture, this foal is eligible for registration as “foundation stock” as it was conceived on park. You must notify the Assn within 30 days of foaling.
8. Only stock purchased through the GFHHA are eligible to carry the FGF brand. If your horse is unbranded on leaving the holding facility or conceived on park and born in your care it is your responsibility to return it for branding when suitable.
9. Guy Fawkes horses obtained from Save the Brumbies will carry the KSW brand. For these horses to be eligible for “foundation stock” registration you must provide a colour copy of that horses NPWS ID form with your application. For GF Heritage Horses carrying the KSW Brand to be entered into the GFHHA studbook as foundation stock they must have been captured prior to 2011 and must submit appropriate forms and fees within three (3) months of 01/04/2017.
10. Horses must be branded with the FGF brand to be adult registered as foundation stock.
11. Foals must be foal recorded within 6 months of birth and must be upgraded to adult prior to turning 3 yrs old.
12. If you sell your horse, the purchaser must be a financial member of the GFHHA to apply to transfer the registration of the horse into their name.
13. If you sell your horse to a non-member, the horses’ registration will be suspended. To reinstate the registration, membership will have to be current and registration fees paid to re-instate registration.

**BREEDING GUY FAWKES HERITAGE HORSES**  
**SECTION TWO**

1. Registration is not automatic. For breeders of GFHH's the following conditions and fees apply.
2. Stud prefixes are required for the next generation of Heritage Horses. You must apply for a Stud Prefix using the appropriate form and nominate your preferred Prefix name and registered large stock brand. You will then be required to complete an Annual return every year that you own breeding stock.
3. If you have purchased a breeding mob, the foals born that have been conceived on your property will be eligible to be registered with your prefix. To register these foals you will have to complete stallion service certificates for each mare covered.
4. As of 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017, foal recording application forms for all foals born off park (and appropriate fees) must be received no later than 6 months after the foal's date of birth. You must notify the Assn within 30 days of foaling. Young horses purchased from the GFHHA Inc. eligible for foal recording must have the appropriate forms and fees submitted no later than 3 months after purchase. Failure to record any young stock within this time frame will deem that horse ineligible for foal recording. Adult registration of that horse MAY be allowed once the horse has reached 3 years of age at which time DNA PROOF OF PARENTAGE (supplied by owner) will be required.
5. Horses must be branded with your registered prefix brand to be adult registered.
6. The Assn retains the right to refuse to upgrade a colt to stallion if it is deemed not suitable for breeding.
7. To be eligible for registration any horses not recorded or registered within the set time frames will be required to supply DNA PROOF OF PARENTAGE. DNA testing will be at owner's expense and samples must be collected by a qualified veterinarian. DNA results must be supplied with the application for registration forms and appropriate fees.  
Failure to comply with these rules will deem your horse(s) ineligible for registration.

**PART BRED HERITAGE HORSE REGISTRATION.**  
**SECTION THREE**

The Part Bred registration is open to: -

1. The progeny of registered stallions and unregistered mares. The progeny of registered mares and unregistered stallions.
2. Only mares/ fillies/ geldings are eligible for part registration. Stallions and colts are not eligible.
3. Part bred Heritage Horses do not require foal recording.
4. Part bred Heritage Horses remain part bred. They can never be upgraded to full registration.
5. Owners must show proof of breeding to be able to register a part bred. EG: Stallion service certificate.
6. Owners must be full members of the Guy Fawkes Heritage Horse Association to register full or part bred horses.
7. Registration fee is \$25.00 for life. To transfer or compete, owners must be a full member of the Guy Fawkes Heritage Horse Association.
8. Part Bred horses must be named with the breeders registered prefix, with an X added to the name to denote X bred.
9. Part Bred horses must be branded with the breeders registered prefix brand, with an X added above or below the brand to denote X bred.
